A BRITISH SKYDIVING ADVANCED INSTRUCTOR MUST SIGN THE CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION AT SECTION 3. THE ENDORSEMENT FEE IS £5.00. SUBSEQUENT ENDORSEMENTS ARE £5.00 EACH. LICENCE HOLDERS APPLYING FOR AN ENDORSEMENT MUST RETURN THEIR LICENCE WITH THIS FORM. IF APPLYING FOR AN 'A' LICENCE AT THE SAME TIME AS THE 'B' LICENCE, AN 'A' LICENCE APPLICATION (FORM 190A) MUST ALSO BE COMPLETED AND SENT WITH THIS FORM, INCLUDING BOTH WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS CT & CT1). THE COMBINED FEE IS £15.00. **TWO PASSPORT SIZE PHOTOGRAPHS MUST BE SENT WITH THIS APPLICATION IF THIS IS THE FIRST BRITISH SKYDIVING LICENCE APPLICATION. BRITISH SKYDIVING LICENCES WILL ONLY BE ISSUED TO 'FULL' BRITISH SKYDIVING MEMBERS.**

DESIGNATION AND CLASSIFICATION OF SKYDIVERS (BRITISH SKYDIVING OPERATIONS MANUAL - SECTION 2)

1. Skydivers are Designated as follows:

Student Skydivers	Below British Skydiving 'A' Licence.
British Skydiving Licence holders	See paragraph 3 (below).

2. Skydivers are also Classified in several ways:

British National Skydiving Licence. Issued by British Skydiving and recognised by the Royal Aero Club of the United Kingdom (see British Skydiving Licence, below).

The Category System. British Skydiving Operations Manual, Section 2, Paragraph 4.

Accelerated Free Fall (AFF) Levels. British Skydiving Operations Manual, Section 2, Paragraph 5.

The Grading System. British Skydiving Operations Manual, Section 2, Paragraph 6.

Student Tandem Skydivers. British Skydiving Operations Manual, Section 2, Paragraph 7.

3. BRITISH NATIONAL SKYDIVING LICENCE

British Skydiving 'A' LICENCE: Category 8 & Canopy Training (CT) Written Examination – Form 190A

Before the British Skydiving 'A' Licence is applied for, an Advanced Instructor must have endorsed the application. The CT written examination (Form 240A) must accompany the licence application. The British Skydiving 'A' Licence will then be sent to the applicant with the 'A' Licence section endorsed.

British Skydiving 'B' LICENCE: British Skydiving 'A' Licence, 50 descents and at least Canopy Training Grade 1 (CT1) and Jump Master Grade 1 (JM1) – Form 190B

Before the British Skydiving 'B' Licence is applied for, an Advanced Instructor must have endorsed and stuck into the 'A' Licence at least an CT1 & JM1 Grading System stamp. The CT1 written examination (Form 240B) must accompany the licence application. The British Skydiving Licence will then be returned to the applicant, with the 'B' Licence section endorsed.

British Skydiving 'C' LICENCE: British Skydiving 'B' 200 descents, CT – Grade 2 (CT2), at least one further 'Grade 1' and C Licence Written Examination (Form 326) – Form 190C

Before the British Skydiving 'C' Licence is applied for, an Advanced Instructor must have endorsed and stuck into the Licence the appropriate Grading System stamps. The CT2 written examination (Form 240C) & 'C' Licence written examination must accompany the licence application. The British Skydiving Licence will then be returned to the applicant, with the 'C' Licence section endorsed.

British Skydiving 'D' LICENCE: British Skydiving 'C' Licence, and 1000 descents – Form 190D

The British Skydiving Licence will be returned to the applicant, with the 'D' Licence section endorsed.

Note:

Once British Skydiving 'A' Licence has been obtained, all Grading System stamps are to be endorsed and stuck into the Licence by an Advanced Instructor.
