- Obtained the recommendation of the candidate's CI that the classroom ability of the candidate is satisfactory g. and that they are fully familiar with the procedures and syllabus for teaching and AFF ground school.

DZ controllers or any person talking to a jump aircraft on frequency 129.905 must be in possession of an appropriate ROCC (details may be found in Form 125).
